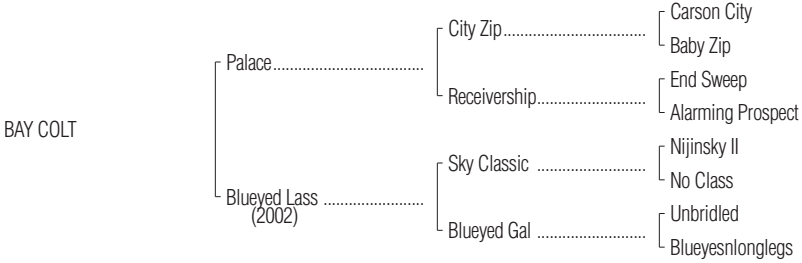

S. Shine Young Futurity-R (EVD, \$7,500)), Palace Avenger (\$74,812), Auberger (\$30,000), Palace Two Step (in 2 starts, \$24,397), Golden Palace (\$24,390), Shanna's Gray (\$23,110).
