

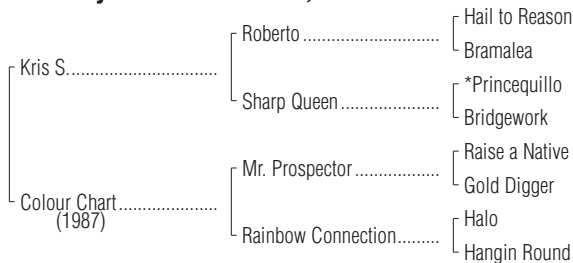

ECOLE D'ART (c. by Theatrical (IRE)). 2 wins at 3, €63,700, in France, Prix de Suresnes, 3rd Prix Le Fabuleux, Prix Pelleas; 2 wins at 5, €32,912, in Ireland; winner at 8, £8,393, in England. (Total: \$133,168).

Barbican (c. by A.P. Indy). 4 wins, 2 to 5, \$126,255, 3rd West Virginia Governor's S. [L] (MNR, \$12,500).
