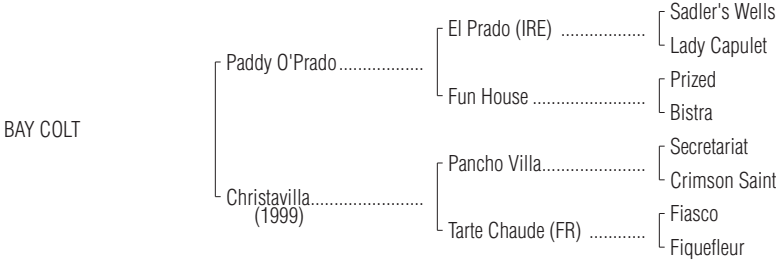

Black-type winner of 5 races, \$1,721,297, Secretariat S. **[G1]** (AP, \$240,000), Virginia Derby **[G2]** (CNL, \$352,800), etc. **His first foals are 2-year-olds of 2015.** Sire of winners Above Fashion (winner in 2 starts, \$55,440, 2nd Cassidy S. (GP, \$14,400)), Paddy's Flight (winner in 2 starts, \$34,400), Glitter O'Prado (winner in 2 starts, \$18,400), Shesthewinner (\$15,621), Gotsomemojo (winner in 1 start, \$12,960). Son of champion El Prado (IRE), leading sire, sire of 83 black-type winners.

CHRISTAVILLA, by Pancho Villa. 4 wins at 4 and 5, \$47,079. Dam of 4 registered foals, 3 of racing age, 2 to race, 2 winners, including-- Volatile Markets (c. by Rockport Harbor). Winner at 3, \$53,232.

TARTE CHAUDE (FR), by Fiasco. 3 wins at 2 and 3 in France, Prix de l'Agence Francaise. Dam of 2 other winners, including-- Suiteepies Success. 3 wins at 4 and 5, \$17,202.

3rd dam

FIQUEFLEUR, by Tarbes. Winner at 3 in France. Dam of 6 winners, including-- **TARTE CHAUDE (FR)**. Black-type winner, above.

Toujours Eux. Winner at 3 in France, 3rd Prix Major Fridolin.

4th dam

CARDANE, by Dan Cupid. Unplaced in 1 start in England. Half-sister to **HOMELY** (Prix Yacowlef, etc.), **TRICTRAC**, **Cartaj**. Dam of 4 winners, including-- **Adalia (GB)**. Winner at 3 in France, 2nd Prix Charles Laffitte; winner at 4, || \$24,050, in N.A./U.S. Producer.

Sententious. Unraced. Dam of 13 foals, 11 to race, 8 winners, including--

Shaisa. 5 wins, 2 to 6 in Norway, champion 3-year-old filly, champion grass mare, champion older mare twice in Scandinavia. 2nd Morten Og Torvald Klaveness Minnelop; 10 wins to 6 in Sweden, 3rd Songline Classic, Songline Classic; winner in Denmark, 3rd Kentaur Pokallob.

Masterkind. 4 wins at 2 and 3 in Norway, champion 3-year-old colt in Scandinavia, champion miler in Scandinavia; 3 wins at 2 and 3 in Sweden, 3rd Taby Open Sprint Championship; placed in 1 start at 4 in Germany, 3rd Euro-American Sprint-Cup.

PROPER LITTLE MISS. Winner at 2 in Belgium, Prix Gutt **[G2]**, 2nd Grand Criterium National d'Ostende **[G2]**, Grand Prix du Centenaire du Jockey-Club, 3rd Les Guinees, Prix E. Van den Bogarde.

LITTLE MISS JOHN. 6 wins, 2 to 6 in Belgium, Le Vase d'Or twice, Prix Madame du Bois de Roest, Prix Sainte Gudule twice, 2nd Prix Albert Van Loo, Prix H. de Theulegoet, etc.; winner at 5, €5,831, in France.
