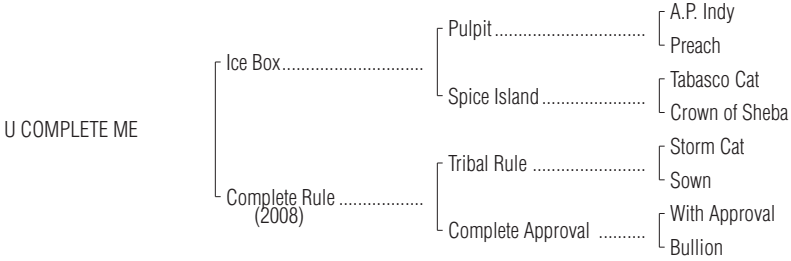

Black-type winner of 3 races at 2 and 3, \$948,068, Florida Derby **[G1]** (GP, \$450,000), 2nd Kentucky Derby **[G1]** (CD, \$400,000). **His first foals are 2-year-olds of 2015.** Sire of Mr Leadbox (placed, \$6,-754). Son of black-type winner Pulpit, sire of 71 black-type winners, including Pyro (5 wins, \$1,673,673, Forego S. **[G1]** (SAR, \$180,000), etc.), Rutherienne (11 wins, \$1,298,671, Del Mar Oaks **[G1]** (DMR, \$240,000), etc.), Corinthian (\$1,267,273, Metropolitan H. **[G1]** (BEL, \$360,000), etc.).

Steady Fire. 4 wins, 2 to 5, \$12,152.
