

Black-type winner of 3 races at 2 and 3, \$832,-744, Arkansas Derby [G1] (OP, \$600,000), etc. **His first foals are 3-year-olds of 2016.** Sire of 253 foals, 99 starters, 47 winners of 68 races and earning \$2,376,170, including Toews On Ice (to 3, 2016, \$307,700, Bob Hope S. [G3] (DMR, \$60,000), etc.), Go No Go (\$119,790, Slide Show S.-R (RP, \$45,000), etc.), Arcature (to 3, 2016, \$105,515, Singletary S. (SA, \$46,800)), black-type-placed Next Shares [G2] (at 3, 2016, \$70,982).
